Time: about 870-800 b. c.

Crisis: Great apostasy and Baal worship under King Ahab in the northern kingdom of Israel (1/2 century after Solomon and division of nation)

Miracles of Judgement

Elijah

Drought in Israel 1st Kings 17:1

Brings fire down upon Ahaziah's army 2nd Kings 1:10-12

Elisha

Strikes down Gehazi with leprosy 2nd Kings 5:26, 27

Reveals the counsel of the king of Syria 2nd Kings 6:12

Strikes the army of the king of Syria with blindness 2nd Kings 6:18

The destruction of Sennacherib's army 2nd Kings 19:35; Isa 37:36

Miracles over Nature (Signs)

Elijah

Is fed by ravens 1st Kings 17:6

Is fed by an angel 1st Kings 19:1-8

Increases the widow's meal and oil 1st Kings 17:9-16; Lu 4:26

Rain in answer to Elijah's prayer 1st Kings 18:41-45

Divides the Jordan River 2nd Kings 2:8

Is transported to the heavens 2nd Kings 2:11

Elisha

Divides the Jordan River 2nd Kings 2:14

Increases a widow's supply of oil 2nd Kings 4:1-7

Feeds one-hundred men 2nd Kings 4:42-44

Causes the ax to float 2nd Kings 6:6

Causes the eyes of his servant to be opened 2nd Kings 6:17

Miracles of Jesus

Time: about 1-33 a. d.

Crisis: End of the time of waiting; the messiah arrives

Miracles of Judgement

Condemns a fig tree Mt 21:17-22; Mk 11:12-14, 20-24

Passes unseen through the crowd John 4:28-30

Miracles over Nature (Signs)

Water converted into wine Jn 2:1-11

The catch of fish Lk 5:1-11

Stills the storm Mt 8:23-27; Mk 4:35-41; Lk 8:22-25

Feeds more than 5,000 people Mt 14:15-21, Mk 6:35-44, Lk 9:10-17, Jn 6:1-14

Walks upon Sea of Galilee Mt 14:22-33; Mk 6:45-52; Jn 6:16-21

Feeds more than 4,000 people Mt 15:32-39; Mk 8:1-9

The temple tax money obtained from a fish's mouth Mt 17:24-27

Heals the nobleman's son Jn 4:46-54 **A, C**

Heals the demoniac in the synagogue Mk 1:23-26; Lk 4:33-36 **B**

Cleanses the leper Mt 8:1-4; Mk 1:40-45; Lk 5:12-16 **C**

Heals the paralyzed man Mt 9:1-8; Mk 2:1-12; Lk 5:17-26 **B**

Heals the man by the pool Jn 5:1-16 **E**

Restores the withered hand Mt 12:9-13; Mk 3:1-5; Lk 6:6-11 **E**

Raises Lazarus from the dead Jn 11:1-46 **A, B, C**

Heals the woman with the spirit of infirmity Lk 13:10-17 **E**

Cures a man with dropsy Lk 14:1-6 **E**

Restores sight to two blind men near Jericho Mt 20:29-34; Mk 10:46-52; Lk 18:35-43 **C**

Heals the ear of Malchus Lk 22:49-51 **B, D**
